- 1. Three tanburs, a rubab, a dutar, a gijjak, a balabon, a double flute, a dulcimer, a tambourine;
- 2. Two tanburs, a qubuz, a dutar, a nay (flute), a tambourine;
- 3. Two tanburs, a qubuz, a tambourine (dutar can also be added);
- 4. A tanbur, a dutar, at least a tamborine.

As noted by President Sh.M. Mirziyoyev, musical theoretical knowledge is one of the most important factors in leading the next generation to maturity. This process represents a high level of knowledge efficiency through the analysis, selection, design and control of all governing organizational units and their interrelationships, as well as the introduction of a systematic approach to this issue.
