Matching heading.

In this question type of reading we match the heading to the paragraph. The headings will be given in a list. Initially we recommend you to read the text. Because there are more options than you need. So, analyze all of the headings in order to find the correct answer. We should mention that the answers, which is given in the text or passage, do not come in order.

True/False/Not given

There are given information in the question and we should find the true answer from the text. In this question type, understanding plays main role.

True – the same information in the question and passage

False – the opposite information in the question and passage

Not given – the information is not found in the passage

Matching paragraph information question

In the passage there are given paragraphs you should match the information which is given in the question with found information in one of the paragraphs. The information which is in the question should be paraphrased. Next tip for matching paragraph information question is finding the information that is appropriate to the passage. In addition, all the paragraphs can not be used.

Summary completion question

In this question type, the given gaps as a summary completion question is filled from given words in a box or passage. The first tip for this question type is knowing the type of word which is needed for completing the gap. Moreover, the difference of this type of question from other types of questions is that all answers come sequentially. We need to pay attention to how many words should be used for each answer and also ,you should find the answer that can be grammatically correct.
