

## UZBEKISTAN HAS CREATED A NEW STAGE IN THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN

The President of the Republic of Uzbekistan attached to the state leaders for individual work with young people and their support.

So how is this planned?

On April 11, 2023, the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan appointed 50 young people to the heads of enterprises and institutions operating in the Denov district of the Surkhandarya region in connection with the execution of the tasks given at the meeting of the video selector. Governors, deputy governors, the Department of Internal Affairs, the National Security Service, hospitals, banks, professors of higher educational institutions are assigned to these leaders.



What kind of work does the leader do with the young people assigned to him?

It is planned that the leaders will ensure the employment of the young people assigned to them, provide quality education, vocational training and proper organization of free time, provide all-round support to young people in need of social assistance, and implement measures to form a common sense and worldview in them.

In it, the problems of young people are studied and divided into categories, planned work with young people and organization of meetings with them is defined.

Boys and girls between the ages of 14 and 30 living in the Denov district of the Surkhandarya region, who have problems in their living conditions, are interviewed, their problems are studied, and practical help is provided to them in a short time.



For example, the problems of citizens living in "Gulobod", "Mehnatabad", "Oybarak", "Dahana" neighborhoods of the district were solved.

What problems are bothering these young people?

Citizen F. Sharipov, who lives in "Gulobod" neighborhood, has a limited ability to walk, but he asked for a computer set in order to gain worldly knowledge and use digital technology, his appeal was resolved.

A computer set was given to him in order to use computer services. Also, S. Qabilov, a resident of "Mehnatabad" neighborhood with physical disabilities, asked for a refrigerator and a fan to improve his family's living conditions. Based on his request, household items were taken away.





In addition, in order to solve the problems of the youth by the state and to systematically support the youth, the "Youth Register" was introduced in Uzbekistan. In order to provide material and moral support to young people, 25 directions have been defined.

4 young people were included in the "Youth register" because the government guaranteed the solution of problems in these 25 areas. Also, in order to restore and maintain their health, all attached youths are undergoing medical examination.

Additional information: today there are more than 17,000 people aged 14 to 30 in Denov district. Of these, 3,736 young people with social problems are assigned to 66 leaders.

In the state of Uzbekistan, boys and girls have access to free education and medical services. This ensures that the citizens of the state are healthy and educated.
