The agricultural products grown in the villages of Angor District, Surkhandarya Region of the Republic of Uzbekistan are getting rich in vitamins in the golden rays of the sun. Therefore, there is a demand for products not only in domestic markets, but also in foreign countries. Clusters and enterprises producing agricultural products in the district are operating on the basis of demand and desire. One of these enterprises is the foreign enterprise "Tanovar Surkhan" located in "Yukori Tallimaron" neighborhood of Angor district. This enterprise started its activity in 2018. 154 hectares of land has been allocated for the project of organizing the cultivation of agricultural products. The enterprise mainly grows and exports products such as cabbage, tomatoes, bell peppers and early morning melons.



Based on the decision of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated December 30, 2021 "On the approval of the investment program of the Republic of Uzbekistan for 2022-2026 and the introduction of new approaches and mechanisms for managing investment projects", systematic work is being carried out at the enterprise.

In particular, according to the task given to each district on the absorption of foreign direct investment funds worth 50.0 million dollars per year, the foreign enterprise of "Tanovar Surkhan" Limited Liability Company plans to absorb a total of 3.0 million dollars of foreign direct investment funds in 2023-2024. . This the employees of the enterprise are working diligently to implement the plan.



At this point it is worth saying that now is the time of innovation. Innovations are being introduced in all areas. The drip irrigation method is widely used in the agricultural sector to obtain abundant and high-quality crops. Likewise, drip irrigation has been introduced in this foreign enterprise. Since the beginning of the year, 752 tons of products worth 5 million 200 thousand dollars have been exported to foreign countries. It is planned to export 18,650,000 dollars worth of products by the end of the year. This year, planned activities are being carried out in order to increase the type and volume of exported products.



Four or five years ago, agricultural products were mainly exported to Russia, Kazakhstan, and Ukraine, but today they are exported to many countries, especially to Latvia, Lithuania, Belarus and other countries. This is a sign of increasing demand in the world market for agricultural products grown on the land of Angor district of Surkhandarya region of the Republic of Uzbekistan.
