Such a lesson does not meet the requirements of today. The students are just listeners. Ready-made knowledge is shared with students by the teacher. However, in the National Training Program, the first priority is to determine the national model of training. It involves a new approach to the student, the teacher, the leader, and a new set of requirements. The main purpose of education is not to educate children as before, but to teach them to learn. At the same time, students should not only be passive listeners, but also active participants in the learning process. This means that the relationship between teacher and student and the state of mind in the learning process must change radically.
